

# Depression research wants to bring light back to your view.

Learn about the **VENTURA-7** research study for adults with major depressive disorder (MDD) who experience a loss of interest or pleasure. This study is evaluating an oral investigational medication that is taken in addition to your current antidepressant medication to which you have had an unsatisfactory response.

The main purpose of this study is to see if the once daily oral study medication is safe and effective for depression symptoms when it is taken in addition to your current antidepressant medication.

To potentially be in this study, you must:

- Be 18 to 64 years of age
- Have been diagnosed with depression
- Be experiencing depressive symptoms, including loss of interest or the ability to feel pleasure, despite currently taking antidepressant medication

If you are interested in learning more about the study, the study doctor will discuss additional eligibility requirements. All study visits and study-required medical care will be provided at no cost to you. The time commitment for study participation is up to 36 weeks (about 9 months).
